

David Machado Approved As New State Charter School Director

RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - David Machado, chief administrator of the Lincoln Charter School in Lincoln County, will be the state's new director of the Department of Public Instruction's Office of Charter Schools.

The state Board of Education approved his appointment Wednesday.
