RALEIGH, (SGRToday.com) - Gov. Pat McCrory begins the post-Memorial Day work week with a bill signing ceremony at the Executive Mansion. The governor will sign Senate Bill 445, known as "Burt's Law";

The bill provides for penalties for people who don't report abuse in group homes.

The signing ceremony begins at 11:30 a.m. It is open to credentialed press.
